

Milton Township Highway Department has had inquiries regarding the continued construction of the sidewalk along Pleasant Hill Road. Engineering for the full 1100 feet of the sidewalk was completed last year and the Township will continue the construction of the remaining sidewalk this year. We will be coordinating our efforts with Illinois American Water Company who will be doing work to their water main in the same area. The work will continue to be monitored as final construction for the remainder of the walk progresses. That would include the need for improved weather conditions.

**605 ILCs 5/6-201.12 (Lighting of roads)**

***Sec. 6-201.12. Provide for the lighting for any public road or portion thereof, in his district when in his opinion it is necessary for the convenience or safety of the public.***

**605 ILCs 5/6-201.14 (Construction of curbs, sidewalks, alleys and bike paths)**

***Sec. 6-201.14. Have authority to build curbs, sidewalks, alleys, and bike paths in unincorporated communities out of any funds belonging to the road district in which such community is located.***

Don't forget about the Township Brush Pick-Up program starting  
May 4, 2009.

Brush should be tied in bundles with twine, DO NOT USE WIRE. Brush should be no longer than 4 feet in length and 3 inches in diameter and not over 25 pounds. The Highway Department does not accept any yard waste in bags, containers or garbage cans.

Brush should be out no later than 7:00 am on the Monday of the scheduled pick-up. The Highway Department will come by and pick up the brush sometime during the week.
