

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE INSTALLATION

OF TIME RESTRICTED NO PARKING SIGNS

WHEREAS, the Milton Township Highway Commissioner has determined that the sections of Milton Township Highways hereinafter described are threatened by vehicular parking which is causing deterioration of the road edge and parkway areas, and

WHEREAS, the residents of the area concerned have petitioned the Milton Township Highway Commissioner to install the NO PARKING DURING SCHOOL HOURS, and


WHEREAS, the Milton Township Highway Commissioner has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town of Milton and the taxpayers residing therein that the hereinafter described area be restricted as ones of NO PARKING DURING SCHOOL HOURS.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Township Highway Commissioner of Milton Township, Du Page County, Illinois, that the following described sections of Milton Township Highways be restricted to NO PARKING DURING SCHOOL HOURS, and hereby grant the prayer of the petition pursuant to the authority granted by statutes (121-6-201.16).

East and west sides of Seneca Drive from Durfee Road to south sidewalk and crosswalk of school


IN WITNESS WHEREOF the said Township Highway Commissioner of Milton Township has adopted this Ordinance this 5th day of January 1973.
