

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE INSTALLATION
OF TIME RESTRICTED NO PARKING SIGNS

0-77-1

WHEREAS, the Milton Township Highway Commissioner has determined that the section of Milton Township Highway hereinafter described is threatened by vehicular parking which is causing deterioration of the road edge and parkway areas; and in the area of the Stop sign, blocking the view of the Stop sign and traffic.

WHEREAS, the Milton Township Highway Commissioner has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town of Milton and the taxpayers residing therein that the hereinafter described area be restricted as zones of NO PARKING AT ANYTIME.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Township Highway Commissioner of Milton Township, DuPage County, Illinois, that the following described section of Milton Township Highway be restricted to NO PARKING AT ANYTIME, and hereby grant the prayer of the petition pursuant to the authority granted by statutes (121-6-201.16).

DESCRIPTION OF RESTRICTED HIGHWAY

East and West sides of Golf Lane,
from Hill Avenue to Fairway Street
