

WHEREAS, Delano Street is an improved roadway running in a generally north/south direction in the Township of Milton, County of DuPage, State of Illinois, a

WHEREAS, the Milton Township Highway Commissioner and the Milton Township Board of Trustees have determined, after careful consideration and investigation, that the interests of public safety and public welfare of the residents of the Township will best be served if the said Delano Street is restricted as a one-way street, for northbound traffic only, for traffic on Delano between Geneva Road on the south and McArthur on the north and,

WHEREAS, specific approval for the imposition of such one-way traffic restriction has been previously obtained from Mr. Karl B. Fry, DuPage County Superintendent of Highways and,

WHEREAS, Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 139, Section 126.24 authorizes the Milton Township Board of Trustees to provide for the installation of traffic control devices, signage and the like, and,

WHEREAS, Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 121, Section 6-201.16 gives specific authority to the Milton Township Highway Commissioner to place, erect, and maintain upon township roads such signage and other traffic control devices as may be authorized pursuant to the Illinois Vehicle Code, as amended from time to time and,


WHEREAS, the undersigned Milton Township Highway Commissioner and the undersigned Milton Township Board of Trustees deem it to be in the best interests of the public safety and welfare to enact this ordinance,

NOW THEREFORE the undersigned do hereby and by execution of this document ordain, declare, and decree the following to be known as Milton Township Ordinance No. 90-4:

1. The foregoing recitals are merged and incorporated as material provisions of this Ordinance, as though fully set forth herein.
2. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, Delano Street shall be and is hereby declared to be a one-way street, for northbound traffic only, including that portion of Delano Street lying between its intersections with Geneva Road on the south, and McArthur Avenue on the north and all portions of Delano Street between said intersections.
3. That the Milton Township Highway Commissioner shall cause appropriate signage to be erected and maintained designating said portion of Delano Street as a one-way street in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.
4. That from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful, and a violation of this Ordinance, to operate any motor vehicle (as defined in the Illinois Vehicle Code) in a southbound direction on Delano Street between its intersections with Geneva Road on the south and McArthur Avenue on the north.
5. Violations of this Ordinance shall be punishable by citation, fine, or such other penalties as are provided in the Illinois Vehicle Code.
6. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after May 15, 1990.


